Introduction to Medical Occupations

Family and Consumer Sciences Education Co-op – students with a career interest or current employment within the areas of childcare, hospitality, fashion construction and design, interior design or healthcare related occupations may benefit from the added component of a classroom segment specifically designed to increase knowledge and skill in general as an employed person. Students will explore additional employment opportunities and provide specific need based skill development related to current employment. This is a course to complement the student's job experience competencies in any occupation in the multi-faceted Family and Consumer Sciences Education area. If the student is not employed, the instructor will assist in exploring opportunities. Coordination of effort in training is between the employer and classroom teacher. Student has to obtain instructor's permission to enroll in this course. One credit is earned for the classroom component and 1-3 credits are earned for work "on-the-job" (4 credits maximum). The advantage of this course is that the student obtains supervision and encouragement to improve by both professionals with training in the field as well as the employer. DPI Employability Skills certification is available for successful completion of course. Health Youth Apprenticeship – For students focused on a career in nursing or other medical related jobs. Students apply through their counselor in early March of their sophomore or junior year and attend four Lakeshore Technical College courses (5.5 college credits) that align with their paid work experience. Transportation must be available for travel to work site and LTC campus. A mentor is assigned to the student at the job site.
