

VSP GIFT CERTIFICATES

There is a national program entitled “Sight for Students” that offers gift certificates for a free eye exam and glasses. Certificates are disseminated by nationally-certified school nurses and are able to be used with preferred providers in our community.

The eligibility criteria are:

- Family income is at or below 200% of poverty level (see below) or student qualifies for free/reduced school lunch.
- Child is not covered by Medicaid/Badgercare/Forward Card or any other vision insurance.
- Child is 18 years old or younger and has not graduated from high school.
- Child or parent is a U.S. citizen or documented immigrant with a social security number. A social security number is required.
- Child has not used the program during the last 12 months.

Should your student qualify for a Sight for Students Voucher, please contact your school nurse. She will then mail you a certificate. ***Please know that if they request a voucher and they do not qualify that they could be billed and expected to pay for the services provided.***
