One of the strengths of the Sheboygan Area School District is the variety of opportunities and choices offered to families, especially when it comes to school choice. Every student is guaranteed enrollment in their neighborhood school, which is determined by the student's home address. Families also have the opportunity to request to attend a different school in the District.

No matter which location you choose, you will find all our schools offer a comprehensive education built on innovation, strong communication, and whole-student well-being. Every school educates a little differently, making them each unique, which in turn offers you the chance to tailor an education path that fits your child's needs and goals.

We celebrate the diversity of our community, and our schools reflect that. Some offer very specialized learning, such as the [Dual Language Program](#) at Sheridan Elementary School which offers academic instruction in both English and Spanish. Students may begin the Dual Language Program in 4-year-old kindergarten (4K) at the Early Learning Center and continue on through middle school at Horace Mann. The Sheboygan Area School District also offers [eight tuition-free public charter school options](#) for families seeking schools that are unique in design and focus. 

State Report Cards for Districts and Schools Released

Last week, the WI Department of Public Instruction released report cards for districts and schools. The Sheboygan Area School District rating remains as *Meets Expectations*. As part of the District's goal of continuous improvement, the report cards are one measure the District will use, in combination with a variety of other school and district data, to determine the areas we are performing well and the areas where we need to focus improvement.

The Sheboygan Area School District also compiles our own data to create College and Career Readiness Report Cards for students and schools. The SASD was one of the first districts to be tracking data such as attendance, community service, workplace learning experiences, dual credit course enrollment, participation in co-curricular activities, GPA, ACT scores, and other course participation related to college-readiness and using it to measure students' readiness to enter college or a career after graduation.

The SASD Career and College Readiness Report Cards show individual students, as well as schools if they are meeting the benchmarks we have established for students who plan to enter directly into a career or plan to attend a two-year or a four-year college. The benchmarks were selected to ensure that our students have relevant coursework, academic performance, and workplace experience to prepare them for success after high school. This report card is directly tied to our Academic and Career Planning (ACP) process and our district goal of preparing students to take the next step in their self-defined career pathway.




Join Us for Hour of Code at South High on December 9
