

ASVAB TEST

GENERAL INFORMATION

Purpose:

According to the Official Site of the ASVAB, this test is “a multiple-aptitude battery that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military”. (<http://official-asvab.com/>)

- “ASVAB scores are used to determine if you are qualified to enlist in the military and to assign you to an appropriate job in the military.” (http://official-asvab.com/docs/asvab_fact_sheet.pdf)

Who takes the ASVAB?

It is recommended for 11th and 12th grade students who are considering a career in the military.

Is the ASVAB test optional or required?

The ASVAB test is optional. However, if you are entering the Military, you will have to complete the exam.

What areas does the ASVAB test cover?

The test is comprised of 9 sub-tests:

- General Science
- Arithmetic Reasoning
- Word Knowledge
- Paragraph Comprehension
- Mathematics Knowledge
- Electronics Information
- Auto and Shop Information
- Mechanical Comprehension
- Assembling Objects

SCORE REPORTING INFORMATION

How do I receive my ASVAB test scores?

Students will receive their scores at an interpretation session which is held in the Coach's Office (Room 170). It will take place during 6th hour. Students will receive a pass from the Student Services Office excusing them from class. Students will receive a copy of their scores; North will also have a copy to keep in their academic records.
