When you decide to volunteer with CASA and are accepted into the program, you will undergo thorough training and will be supported by professional staff. As a CASA, you are the most consistent adult for the child.

 - Gain a deeper understanding of the intersection of child development, trauma, and mental health.
 - Work with foster parents, families, CPS, the court, etc. to figure out the best solution possible for the child
