Sheboygan Area School District students (age 5 and older) and their parents/guardians are invited to receive the **Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine** in collaboration with Prevea Health. You do not need to be a Prevea patient to receive a COVID-19 vaccine from us.

Second dose of Pfizer

APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED; LIMITED WALK-INS.

Masks required. Please bring your insurance card; however, insurance is not required.

Dosage and administration:

- Adolescents age 12 years and older receive the same dosage of the Pfizer vaccine as adults.
- Children ages 5 through 11 years receive one-third of the adult dose of the Pfizer vaccine. *If your child is turning 12 during the three weeks between doses one and two, we recommend waiting to vaccinate until they turn 12 so they can receive the greater dosage. Vaccine dosage does not vary by patient weight but by age on the day of vaccination.*

Parental/guardian consent:

- Individuals who are 5 to 15 years of age must have a parent/guardian present for both doses.
- Individuals who are 16 and 17 years of age are required to have parent/guardian consent to receive vaccination. In the event that a parent/guardian cannot be present, a consent form must be signed and brought to both doses.

There is no cost for the vaccine and immigration status is not needed. Translation device will be available. For more information, visit: prevea.com/vaccine
