IMPACT OF FEDERAL FUNDING CUTS ON SCHOOL MEALS

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has ended the Local Food for Schools (LFS) program which connects Wisconsin schools with local small farmers and producers to provide students with unprocessed or minimally processed foods.

There is no impact on the SASD at this time .



TRANSITION TO BULK

-ITEM BREAKFASTS

- Benefits of Bulk -Item Breakfasts vs Breakfast Kits:
 -  Reduces waste—students select only what they want.
 -  Allows for better food options, such as fresh fruit.
 -  Improves cost-effectiveness.
- December:
 - Shifted from breakfast kits to bulk-item breakfasts at Sheboygan Leadership Academy and Lake Country Academy.
 - These schools serve meals from the cafeteria.
- February:
 - Longfellow adopted the bulk-item breakfast model.
- Future plans to expand to additional schools.



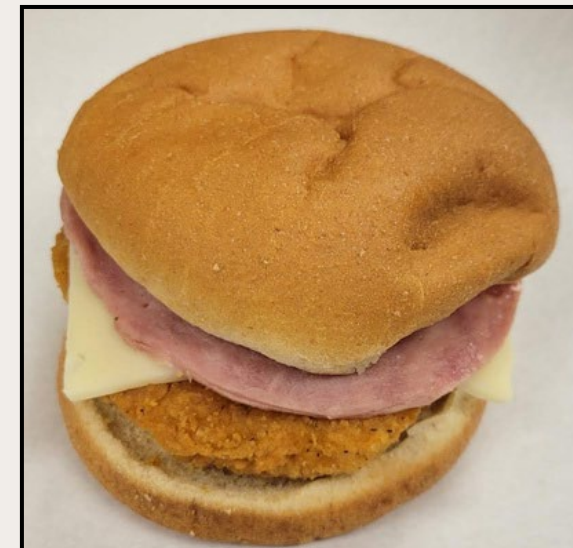

REIMBURSEMENT & FOOD COSTS

Lunch Reimbursement Rates Over the Past 3 Years

- 2022 - 2023: \$4.43 per meal
- 2023 - 2024: \$4.35 per meal (- 1.8%)
- 2024 - 2025: \$4.45 per meal (+2.27%)

Trends show a .45% increase in federal reimbursements

Impact of Rising Food Costs

Food prices have surged by 25% over the past five years, with some items experiencing even greater increases. The rising costs of fresh produce, dairy, and proteins have made it more challenging to maintain meal quality while staying within budget.
