KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST 2024-2025

At the beginning of the year there are always a few things parents have to know:

1. **SUPPLIES** your kindergartner will need the first day of school:

- (1) Box crayons (16 or 24 count) NO FLUORESCENTS
- (4) LARGE/JUMBO glue sticks OR 8 little glue sticks (Elmer's only)
- (1) School bag/backpack (must bring every day)
- (2) Large box of Kleenex
- (1) Plastic school box – no bigger than 8" x 5" – no handle
- (1) Box of 10 count classic color, broadline markers (No skinny markers please)
- (6) #2 pencils, sharpened
- (1) Vinyl folder for daily take home
- (2) Expo Dry Erase BLACK low odor markers
- (1) Fiskars student scissor, blunt tipped
- (1) Student sized headphones to keep at school for computer lab/iPads **(NO EARBUDS)**

SPARE CHANGE OF CLOTHES (shirt, pants, underwear and socks) TO BE KEPT IN LOCKER

Students do NOT need to have an extra pair of gym shoes in Kindergarten but they MUST either wear or bring gym shoes (no Crocs or Hey Dudes) on PE days.

2. **ART SUPPLIES**

- (1) Paint shirt (old adult T-shirt works best) To be kept in locker
- (1) Box of markers ***PLEASE LABEL THEM FOR ART

3. **Marking Supplies:** Label all of your child's supplies with a **permanent marker**. This will help identify the owner if an item is lost.
4. **Excuses:** The school is required by state law to have a written excuse for any absence or a call to the school office (459-3689) the day of the absence or appointment (dentist, doctor, etc.). Please comply or the school office will call you.
5. **Birthdays:** Please do not send birthday invitations to school or pick up children after class for birthday parties. It is very difficult to explain to a child why he/she was not invited. Please DO NOT bring cake for birthday snack.
6. **Immunizations:** The State of Wisconsin requires students beginning kindergarten have the following immunizations: 4-5 DTP/DT/Td, 4 Polio, 2 Measles, Mumps, Rubella, 3 Hept. B and 1 Varicella (chicken pox) or date of disease. One DTP/DT and polio must be given after the child's fourth birthday in order to meet the requirement for school entrance. Contact the Health Department for times when these immunizations are given free of charge or at a nominal fee. **The Sheboygan Area School District requires a physical exam be on file for all incoming kindergartners.** If your child attended the Early Learning Center, chances are this exam is already on file. A dental checkup and eye exam are suggested.
7. **Bus:** There is no school district provided bussing for Wilson. In the past, the Sheboygan Transit System has provided bussing. You can contact Shoreline Metro for more information.
