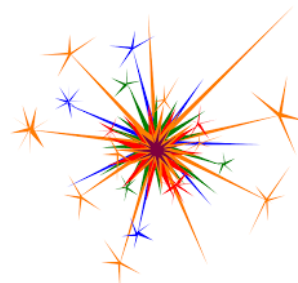




PLYMOUTH FAIRGROUNDS MAP AND DIRECTIONS

From the East or West on Hwy 23: Take State Hwy 23 to STH 57. Turn south on STH 57 for about 1/2 mile, turn west on CTH C at Fleet Farm. Take CTH C (which is named Eastern Avenue in Plymouth) to Fairview Drive. Turn north on Fairview Drive. The Sheboygan County Fair Park is on the East side of the road. The 4-H Open House is in the Youth Building at the South end of the Fairgrounds.
