

What is RITE?

The Residency in Teacher Education (RITE) program is a Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) approved teacher licensure program. The RITE program provides formal instruction in the planning and delivery of effective instructional practices, assessment of student progress, classroom management, and educational technology implemented during a residency-based teaching experience.

The “RITE” Candidate

The “RITE” candidate will hold a bachelor's degree, or higher, in the desired field of licensure from an accredited Institution of Higher Education with at least a cumulative 2.75 GPA. Note: ESL and Special Education candidates may possess a bachelor's degree, or higher, in any area of study. Candidates must also meet Basic Skills and Content Knowledge requirements. RITE 1.5 is a 15 month program for teachers hired on a [1-Year License with Stipulations](#) needing to complete work toward licensure, teacher hired on [Experience-Based license](#), as well as individuals who are not hired and looking to begin coursework to earn Special Education or ESL licensure.* See [Licensing Options](#) on page 3, RITE 1.0. In Year 2, of RITE 1.5, full-time residency work is required, see [RITE Residency Placement/Partnership Agreements](#).

Bachelor's Degree

Applicant must hold a Bachelor's Degree (or higher) from a [regionally accredited college or university](#).

OR

Hold credential evaluation confirming the equivalent of a bachelor's degree earned outside the United States.

Grade Point Average (GPA)

Applicant must have an **undergraduate 2.75 GPA or higher** on a four-point scale or **cumulative Master's degree GPA of 3.0 or higher** on a four-point scale as demonstrated on official transcripts.

OR

Demonstration of academic growth including, but not limited to, successful continued coursework, military or employment-related learning that demonstrate a candidate's ability to be successful in a rigorous program of academic study.
