NOTICE TO PARENTS OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

All students are expected to register online prior to the start of the school year, including students in Special Education, English Language Learner Programs, and Early Learning Programs. With online registration, parents/guardians will be able to register their child(ren) for school, complete all necessary school district forms and pay any required and optional fees. Registration packets will not be distributed. Directions for the online registration process will be posted on the SASD website at www.Sheboygan.k12.wi.us at the end of July. **If you do not have a computer or internet access, you may call your school office to schedule an appointment for in person registration assistance.** If you have a child who will be enrolling in a SASD school for the first time, please contact the school office to schedule an appointment to register in person at that school. Health forms for seizures, diabetes, asthma, and Anaphylaxis/Allergy (other than seasonal allergies or allergies to medications) and forms if your child will need medications at school may either be mailed home or picked up in the school office.

Offices of the high schools will be open for in person registration assistance according to the following schedule. Principals will be available to confer with parents on questions related to enrollment.

High School Registration Fee	\$65.00
Student Activity Ticket (Optional)	\$60.00

At North and South High School there will be a \$5.00 Physical Education fee for all freshman, sophomores, and juniors and for seniors who take a Physical Education class.

At South High School there will be a \$30.00 fee for bowling for all seniors who are taking Physical Education during second semester. Also, all South High School band members will be charged \$15.00, and choir members \$10.00 at registration for uniform cleaning which will be done at the end of the school year.

The Student Activity Ticket may be paid for along with other fees and covers admission to most school activities, a subscription to the school newspaper for one year, and the school yearbook.

The Student/Parent Planner–Handbook is required for all students attending North and South. Parents and students are encouraged to review the extremely important information enclosed within these planners/handbooks.
