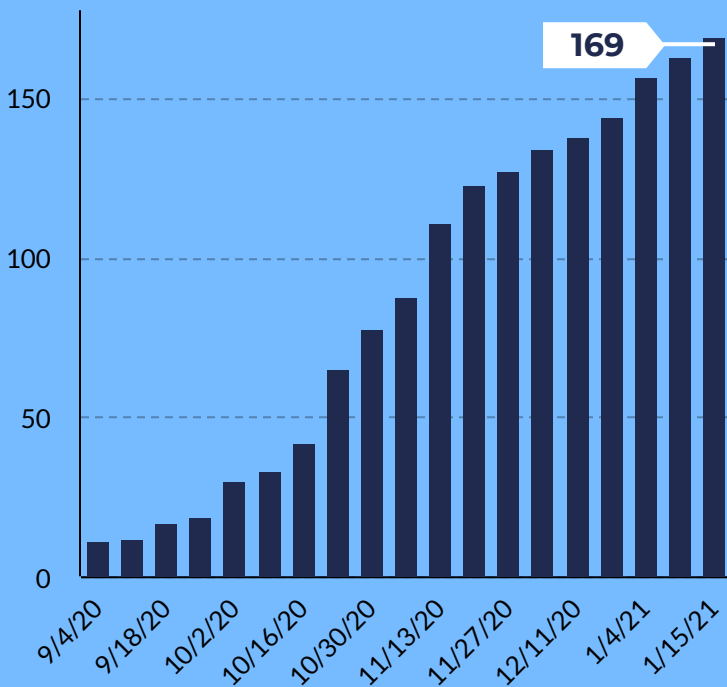
## Decision Making Metrics for In-Person Learning

No single metric provides a universal fit given the uniqueness of each school district. We continue to take the following guidance into account when discussing the safety of face-to-face schooling.

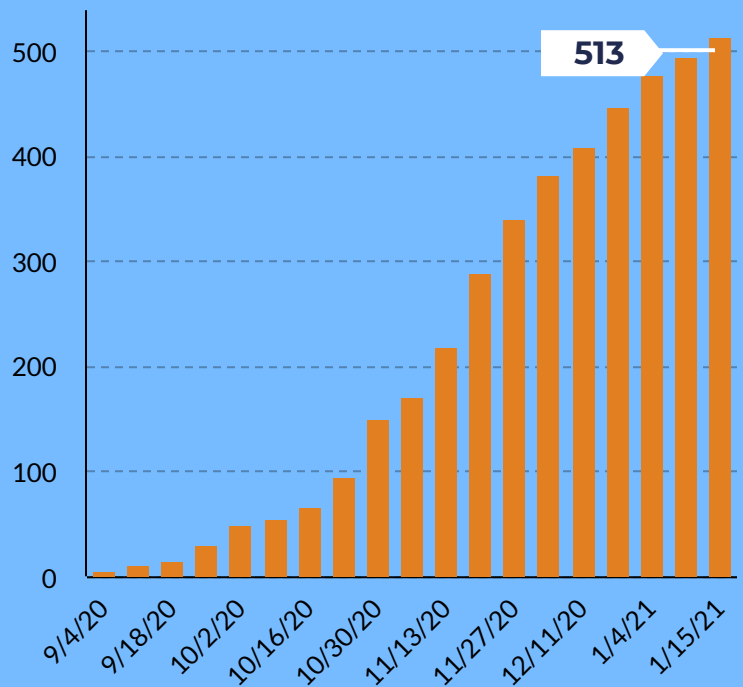
