June 2025 Update

WHAT'S NEW?

Design progress continues steadily at both Farnsworth and Urban Middle Schools, with the project crossing several key milestones in recent weeks. Over the past month, Bray Architects presented updates to the Board of Education, hosted community meetings at both middle schools, and most recently engaged with the City of Sheboygan's Historic Preservation Committee. The feedback from these sessions has been overwhelmingly positive—especially regarding the evolving exterior designs.

PLANNING & DESIGN UPDATE

Recent planning and design efforts have spanned a variety of focus areas. Notably, geotechnical borings began in early June at both middle school sites. Drill rigs on continuous tracks were on-site at both locations conducting subsurface analysis to assess soil conditions and identify any buried materials that could affect construction. Results from this testing are expected by late June or early July.

Meanwhile, initial conversations with the administrative and principal teams have begun to explore flooring, wall, and ceiling materials that will help create dynamic and effective learning environments. Bray Architects is now translating that input into early interior design concepts, which will be reviewed with the Sheboygan Area School District team in August.
